

Coverzone Voyager Car Cover - Fitting and Care Instructions

General Care and Fitting

To properly care for and fit a Coverzone Voyager car cover, start by ensuring your vehicle is clean and free of sharp objects. Unroll the cover from front to back, unfold it, and fit it over the bumpers, securing it with the underbody straps (don't overtighten). For cleaning, hand wash or use a commercial machine on a cold, gentle cycle with mild detergent, and air dry.

Fitting Instructions:

1. Preparation:

Ensure your vehicle is clean and free of sharp objects that could damage the cover.

2. Initial Placement:

Unroll the cover from the front to the back, starting from the roof.

3. Unfolding:

Unfold the sides of the cover, fitting the mirror pockets (if applicable) and pulling the cover over the front and rear bumpers.

4. Securing:

Use the built-in grommets and the provided straps to secure the cover under the vehicle. Do not overtighten the straps.

5. Optional Lock:

For added security, you can use the optional Lock & Cable Kit with the built-in grommets.

Care Instructions:

Cleaning:

Hand Wash: If necessary, install the cover on your vehicle in a shaded area. Hose off loose dirt. Wash with a soft sponge or cloth and mild, biodegradable cleaner if needed. Hose down again and air dry.

Machine Wash: For most Coverzone Voyager covers, you can machine wash them on a cold, gentle cycle with mild detergent. Avoid using bleach or fabric softeners.

Drying: Always air dry your car cover, never use a dryer or heat source.

Storage: When not in use, store the cover in a storage bag.

Repair: If your cover has small tears or holes, you can repair them by applying an inner and outer patch, matching the fabric pattern.

Stubborn Stains: Use a mild soap solution and a soft cloth to gently clean stubborn stains. Do not rub hard.

Bird Lime: Remove bird lime promptly. Apply soap and water to soften it for 5 minutes before wiping.
